By using this simple checklist, you, the property owner, can be assured that you are complying with the law, protecting yourself against unwarranted insurance claims, and that you have an avenue of recourse in the event you do not receive what you contracted for

- 1. Be sure that you receive a clearly written proposal or contract that spells out exactly what will be done, the cost, and the payment methods.
- 2. Beware of any request for unusually large sums of up front money before beginning work.
- 3. Before signing any contract for construction, call your Local Building Department and the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation. They can verify that the company has an active state license and advise you of any complaints that have been filed against the contractor.
- 4. Request a current certificate of insurance, issued to you, as the property owner, from the contractor for general liability and workers' compensation. Any contractor who cannot furnish these documents may not have the coverage required by law, and you, the property owner, may be liable for any claim.
- 5. Require that the contractor obtain the building permit. Never apply for a permit for the contractor.
